- POSITION:** Student Temporary in Civil Engineering
- Students are assigned to highway construction projects throughout Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, Alaska, and Wyoming. Typical assignments may include inspection of contractor's grading, placement of surfacing or paving materials, drainage installation, etc.; monitoring testing of highway materials and soils; or assisting with field office work, such as making computations in connection with plotting field notes, cross sections and profile data, computing areas, and checking field calculations.
- LOCATION:** Field assignments will be to construction projects located throughout the Pacific Northwest. Mobility is a condition of employment. Students must be available for assignment in any of the six states. Travel and per diem expenses are paid.
