



# Salmon River Road



Following is the Contractor's tentative work schedule for the weeks of April 8<sup>th</sup> through April 14<sup>th</sup>.

## Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Camp ground (Extension) Primary Focus:

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Gus Creek the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Continuing with installation of conduit and vaults
- Continue to pull slopes and excavate roadway
- Installation of pipe culverts and catch basins
- Possible rock scaling
- Subexcavation work west of CCC wall

Work in other areas on the project:

- Continue slope cleanup at east of Hot Springs Bridge
- Archaeological investigations/monitoring at Gus Creek
