Following is the Contractor's tentative work schedule for the weeks of April 29th through May 5th.

Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Camp ground (Extension) Primary Focus:

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Hot Springs Bridge the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Continuing with installation of conduit and vaults
- Continue to pull slopes, and excavate roadway
- Installation of pipe culverts and catch basins
- Crushing and screening material for backfill
- Subexcavation work near Ruby Rapids
