Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Camp ground (Extension) Primary Focus:

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Hot Springs Bridge the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Cutting road grade east of Lake Creek Bridge
- Possibly working on subexcavation
- Installation of culvert pipes
- Anticipate utility vault and conduit installation east of Lake Creek Bridge
- Break and stockpile Rip Rap

Between Hot Springs Bridge and Spring Bar Camp Ground the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Possibly pull slopes, and hauling excavation material west of Spring Creek
