## **Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Camp ground (Extension) Primary Focus:**

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Hot Springs Bridge the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Install culverts
- Install irrigation culverts near Gus Creek
- Sort Rip Rap near Lake Creek Bridge
- Possible crusher MSE Wall backfill material located in the Carlson Sheep Pen
- Possible conduit and Power Vault installation
- Possible installation of Turbidity Barrier east of Lake Creek Bridge

Between Hot Springs Bridge and Spring Bar Camp Ground the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Possible slope excavation and hauling
