Following is the Contractor's tentative work schedule for the weeks of June 24th through June 30th. Please note that the week of 4th of July the road will be open 24 hours as the contractor will not be working.

Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Camp ground (Extension) Primary Focus:

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Hot Springs Bridge the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Install culverts between Lake Creek Bridge and Gus Creek
- Install irrigation culverts near Gus Creek
- Sort Rip Rap near Lake Creek Bridge
- Possible crusher MSE wall backfill material located in the Carlson Sheep Pen
- Possible conduit and Power Vault installation
- Possible installation of Turbidity Barrier east of Lake Creek Bridge
- Possible installation on the Turbidity Barrier between Lake Creek bridge and Ruby Rapids

Between Hot Springs Bridge and Spring Bar Camp Ground the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Slope excavation and hauling near Spring Bar


