Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Campground (Extension) Primary Focus:

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Spring Bar Campground the following work is anticipated to take place:

- East of Lake Creek Bridge: Continuing with Mechanically Stabilized Earth Wall excavation/construction and installation of culverts and conduit
- Anticipate starting riprap embankment work west of Hot Springs Bridge
