

## Section 156. — PUBLIC TRAFFIC

### Construction Requirements

#### 156.03 Accommodating Traffic During Work. Add the following:

(a) Accommodate traffic as follows:

(1) **Salmon River Road (Station 1+380 to Station 1+746).** Road is open to traffic with 30 minute delays according to Subsection 156.06(j), except during the Riggins Rodeo that occurs the first Saturday and Sunday in May of each year. Do not delay traffic between 4:00 p.m. Friday and 6:00 a.m. Monday.

(2) **Salmon River Road (Station 1+746 to Station 11+481).** Comply with the following schedule:

(a) The day after Thanksgiving through the last day of February:

- 6:00 a.m. Monday to 6:00 p.m. Friday road closure allowed;
- 6:00 p.m. Friday to 6:00 a.m. Monday open road, no delays allowed.

(b) March 1 through April 14:

- 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. open road, no delays allowed
- 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. road closure allowed
- 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. open road, no delays allowed
- 6:00 p.m. to End of Shift 30 minute delays allowed

(c) April 15 through 6:00 p.m. Thursday before Memorial Day:

- 6:00 a.m. Monday to 6:00 p.m. Thursday road closure allowed
- 6:00 p.m. Thursday to 6:00 a.m. Monday open road, no delays allowed

(d) 6:00 p.m. Thursday before Memorial Day through 6:00 a.m. Tuesday after Memorial Day:

No construction activities allowed.

(e) Tuesday after Memorial Day through 6:00 p.m. Thursday before Labor Day.

(f) 6:00 p.m. Thursday before Labor Day through 6:00 a.m. Wednesday after Labor Day

No construction activities allowed.

(g) Wednesday after Labor Day through September 30.

6:00 a.m. Monday to 6:00 p.m. Thursday road closure allowed  
6:00 p.m. Thursday to 6:00 a.m. Monday 30 minute delays allowed

(h) October 1 through Thanksgiving.

6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. open road, no delays allowed  
8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. road closure allowed  
4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. open road, no delays allowed  
6:00 p.m. to End of Shift 30 minute delays allowed

(i) Holidays. Do not perform construction operations which interfere with public travel on the roadway on any holiday or between 6 p.m. the preceding day and 6 a.m. the following day or as otherwise described above, unless approved by the CO.

(j) The provisions in 156.03 (a)(2)(a) through (a)(2)(h) do not apply between the Notice to Proceed date and January 2, 2008. During this time period, accommodate traffic as follows:

**(b) Transportation and Delivery Services during Road Closures.** Accommodate school employees, school children, local residents, businesses (including their clients) by providing shuttle service at 7:45 a.m., 4:00 p.m., and 6:00 p.m. each day. Do not modify times without the approval of the CO. Notify the public of changes according to Subsection 107.03A.

Furnish shuttle services at each end of the closure by providing vans, buses, water taxi, or other methods approved by the CO. Furnish shuttles and facilities capable of accommodating people (ADA accessible) and supplies. Provide licensed drivers and operate shuttles according to Idaho State Statute.

Provide for Wednesday delivery of mail with the U.S. Postal Service (USPS). Contact the USPS to coordinate delivery time.

Expect increased volumes of people and supplies during special events. Contact the Salmon River Chamber of Commerce in Riggins for more information. Special events include the annual "Women with Bait" steelhead fishing derby held for three weeks during February creating increased activity for the Lodge at Riggins Hot Springs.

Accommodating fuel delivery during closure periods is not required.

Provide a contact with telephone number for local residents, businesses (including their clients), and emergency personnel to notify of pickup and delivery of people and supplies to each end of the closure area.

Construct a gravel surfaced parking area at each end of the closure of sufficient size to accommodate 6 full-size vehicles. Provide access to private land for transportation and delivery services.

**(c) Emergency Services During Road Closures.** Immediately open the road to emergency vehicles or provide access for victims, emergency responders, and their equipment.

Provide for emergency air or water access when vehicle passage is not possible by constructing facilities that will meet the needs of local emergency response units. Coordinate with local emergency responders. Furnish shuttle vehicles to assist during responses. Make facilities available to emergency vehicles throughout the project duration.

**(d) Transportation Plan.** Submit a transportation plan four weeks before road closures for approval by the CO. Include the following:

- The name and telephone number of the contact to coordinate shuttle services;
- Types of shuttle vehicles to be used for transporting people, supplies, victims, and emergency responders;
- A list of licensed shuttle operators;
- Location and size (include a dimensioned drawing) of parking areas;
- An alternate plan in case of equipment failure; and
- Procedures to accommodate special events.

Include an emergency response plan detailing the methods and procedures to be followed during an emergency. Coordinate with Idaho County to develop alternative emergency access methods.
