





### SPRING

H K Contractors, Inc. will only be working on the west side of Logan Pass this 2012 season.

The Sun Road is now in "Spring opening" status with plowing operations in full swing. The park Road Crew is plowing on both sides of Logan Pass while H K Contractors, Inc. is busy clearing snow out of their higher work zone between Haystack and Big Bend to facilitate construction in the area which began last year. The plowing is occurring 7 days a week. In the lower elevations between Avalanche and Logan Creek (3.5 mi.) they are also working Monday through Thursdays 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Until 6 p.m., Mondays through Thursdays, vehicular and non-motorized travel (Hike-Biker) is not allowed beyond the Avalanche gate. Other sights in the Avalanche area remain accessible including Avalanche Lake Trail and the Trail-of-the-Cedars, both popular destinations. On Fridays through Sundays, Hike-Biker access is currently allowed up to the Birdwoman Falls Overlook a distance of 10.7 miles beyond the Avalanche gate. Travelers should always be alert for construction traffic.

Plowing and weather dependent, the Sun Road is expected to be fully open to visitor travel on Friday, June 15, 2012

This year, the Sun Road transit system operates July 1 thru September 3 (Labor Day) from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
