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BEAVER CREEK ROAD NEWSLETTER

In partnership with the US Forest Service and the Crook County Road Department, the Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration will be making substantial improvements to Beaver Creek Road. Located near Paulina, Oregon, the improvements will begin at the intersection of the Paulina/Suplee Highway and Beaver Creek Road and will end approximately 300 feet past the Ochoco National Forest Boundary. Construction operations will be carried out by Tidewater Contractors, Inc.

No construction activities will take place between 6:00 p.m. on the Friday before and 6:00 a.m. the following Tuesday after the upcoming 4th of July weekend.

Construction Progress

Tidewater has begun survey staking for the clearing limits on the Beaver Creek Road project. For the rest of this week and the upcoming week, the contractor will be felling, bucking, and decking merchantable timber on Forest Service land and private land adjacent to the Forest Boundary. The contractor will be carrying out the clearing operation according to accepted logging practices. In compliance with the contract, the timber on cleared land will remain the property of the respective landowner. Tidewater Contractors, Inc. also anticipates starting the surveying and staking operations at the culvert locations starting at the north end of the project and working south. Significant traffic delays are not anticipated for the following weeks.
