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BEAVER CREEK ROAD NEWSLETTER

In partnership with the US Forest Service and the Crook County Road Department, the Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration will be making substantial improvements to Beaver Creek Road. Located near Paulina, Oregon, the improvements will begin at the intersection of the Paulina/Suplee Highway and Beaver Creek Road and will end approximately 300 feet past the Ochoco National Forest Boundary. Construction operations will be carried out by Tidewater Contractors, Inc.

Significant traffic delays during construction are not anticipated for the following week. A maximum delay of 30 minutes is allowed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and between 5:00 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Construction Progress

Tidewater Contractors, Inc have completed the first section of clearing from the north end of the project, just across the Ochoco National Forest Boundary, to approximately 200 meters south of the intersection of FS Road 42 and FS Road 58. Starting next week, Tidewater Contractors, Inc will begin surveying locations for culvert installation starting at the north end of the project and moving south.

As of midnight on July 7, the fire danger level moved from Level 1 to Level 2 restrictions. Fire restrictions are posted on the project, as shown in the photograph below.
