Rimini Road Project

The Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration, in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service, Montana Department of Transportation and Lewis and Clark County, is planning to improve a 6.1-mile section of Montana Forest Highway 98, also known as Rimini Road. As part of this proposed project, 9.8 kilometers (6.1 miles) of the road will be rehabilitated or reconstructed. Representatives from the Federal Highway Administration, the Forest Service and the County will be on hand to answer questions and receive comments.
