



SANDLAKE – GALLOWAY ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

What's happening on the job?

We are still digging out and hauling away that soft blue goop, not to mention all the wood we find buried in the old road. It seems endless, but everyday is one step closer to completion. From the amount of truck traffic moving out mud and hauling in rock it would at times seem like we are trying to wear out the roadway we have already finished. But fear not, those new asphalted sections have but one layer of asphalt and when the project has that first layer of asphalt the full length, a final and yet smoother layer of asphalt will be placed. When you see that second layer the project will be near completion.

Next week the contractor will again work on the segment of Sandlake Road from M.P. 1.05 to M.P. 1.71. The first of the rock layers will begin tomorrow so the weekend everyone will be driving on all gravel instead of gravel and dirt sections.

Also next week our paving contractor Road & Driveways from Newport/Lincoln City is expected to pave in the area of the Three Capes Intersection. This work will take most of the day and will impact not only the everyday user but also those trucks hauling mud and rock. So this intersection will be very busy Wednesday (weather permitting). All I can say is that if you can possibly avoid travel through this area Wednesday, please do. As always our traffic control will try their best to get you through without excessive delays, but with the paving of the intersection its possible that one or two delay periods could exceed the 30-minute duration.

Next week expect traffic delays Monday through Friday. Friday again will utilize a pilot car and 30-minute delays until noon and from noon on only momentary stops (without pilot car). We have not heard any objections to the Friday work schedule so we are assuming everyone like ourselves understands that everyday we can work is one day closer to completion.
